# **DEVELOP** BOWLING IN THE ACT REGION

### Maintain pathways

- Provide opportunities for bowlers at all levels
- Foster or facilitate programs to allow bowlers to progress
- Provide state-based training in both the physical game and game knowledge

### Create opportunities for coaching

- Register valid coaches
- Regulate advertising of coaching services
- Link coaches with learning paths
- Facilitate training for coaches



# **GUIDE** BOWLING IN THE ACT REGION

#### **Educate bowlers on the rules**

- Provide education opportunities on the general rules of the game
- Provide education opportunities for rules specific to leagues
- Provide education opportunities for rules specific to tournaments
- Provide education opportunities for sporting frameworks including member safety and ASADA requirements

### Enforce the rules

- Articulate and guide the jurisdiction for the different management levels
- Identify processes for managing and elevating issues, including appeals and grievances
